









## VSC RESPITE AND WELFARE BREAKS

The Respite and Welfare Break scheme is run by the Victory Services Club (VSC) to support members of the UK Armed Forces.

The scheme delivers one of the Club's long-standing charitable objectives which is to relieve need, hardship or distress among personnel of all ranks. It is administered and funded exclusively by the VSC and provides a two-night break at the Club (including breakfast, lunch and dinner at the Club and tickets for a top London attraction). These breaks are designed primarily to give wounded or injured serving personnel or those who have encountered a significant welfare issue a welcome change of routine and scenery in the Capital, away from their home.

The Trustees and staff of the VSC regard these breaks as a top priority. We always receive excellent feedback from nominees who have been given a Respite and Welfare Break. The process for Recovery, Welfare and military charities to follow is very straightforward and you are invited to look online for our application form.
