FORMOSA (TAIWAN).



HISTORICAL SKETCH.

IN 1590, PORTUGUESE CALLED IT "ILHA FORMOSA" (BEAUTIFUL).
 IN 1622, CORNELIUS REYBSE (DUTCH) SETTLED IN THE PISCADORES,
 & TO PLACATE THEM THE CHINESE WHO ALREADY HAD ESTABLISHED THEM
 SELVES IN FORMOSA IN APPRECIABLE NUMBERS (SINCE A.D. 645), &
 WHO PRACTICALLY DOMINATED THE ISLAND, GAVE THEM PERMISSION
 IN 1623 TO TRADE. "FORT ZELANDIA" WAS ERECTED AT TAINAN
 (AMOY), & LATER A SECOND - "PROVINTIA" IN 1626. THE SPANIARDS
 SETTLED AT KEELUNG, & NAMED IT "LA SANTISIMA TRINIDAD".
 MANY JAPANESE HAVE SETTLED AT TAIPEI SOMETIME AGO.
 CHENG KUNG (KUNING)
 IN 1657 ~~CHENG CHU-LUNG~~ ATTACKED THE DUTCH WITH SUCH
 SHREWDNESS & IMPETUOSITY THAT THOSE WHO WERE NOT
 KILLED, SURRENDERED & WERE PERMITTED TO DEPART FOR
 BATAVIA, WITH THEIR MISSIONARIES. IN 1662 DUTCH AUTHORITY
 CEASED, & IN 1668 THE LAST DUTCHMAN REPAIRED FROM KEELUNG.
 "KUNING" SON OF CHENG CHU-LUNG - (CELEBRATED CORSAIR)
 ESTABLISHED HIMSELF AS SOVEREIGN OF THE ISLAND, OVER WHICH
 HE RULED WITH BARBARIC CRUELTY. HE DIED SOON AFTER.
 IN 1683 THE ISLAND CAME UNDER IMPERIAL CHINA & WAS
 MADE A PART OF FUJEN PROVINCE WITH TAINANFOU - CAPITAL.
 SUCH WAS THE MISGOVERNMENT THAT IT SOON BECAME A
 REFRACATORY REGION, & THE FLOODED & EXASPERATED NATIVES
 (PERHAPS MALAYS, BUT CALLED LONKUS) AFTER KILLING & EATING
 MANY OF THEIR CHINESE CONQUERORS RETIRED TO THE MOUNTAIN
 FASTNESSES & STARTED A RACE-WAR. FOR MANY YEARS THE ISLAND
 WAS NOTORIOUS AMONG SEILORS FOR ITS TREACHEROUS CHIEF
 & FIERCE PEOPLE - THE SEMI-BARBAROUS CHINESE & THE HEAD-
 HUNTING ABORIGINALS. IN 1867 PUNITIVE EXPEDITIONS WERE
 LAUNCHED BY CHINA, & AVOIDED. IN 1874 THE JAPANESE OCCUPIED
 THE SOUTHERN PART OF THE IS. IN 1882 FRANCE SECURED
 THE IS. AS A MATERIAL GUARANTEE FOR PAYMENT OF AN INDEMNITY
 UPON CHINA AT THE CLOSE OF THE FRANCO-CHINESE WAR.
 IN JUNE 1895, THE JAPANESE STORMED TAINANFOU - CAP. &
 SCATTERED THE ADHERENTS OF THE RECENTLY ESTD. REPUBLIC.
 BY THE TREATY OF SHIMONOSEKI - APRIL 17TH 1895, CHINA Ceded
 THE IS. OF FORMOSA & PISCADORES TO JAPAN. IT BECAME
 THE FIRST COLONY OF THE JAPANESE.
